The DSL is affiliated with the National Storytellers League and the National Storytelling Network. Annual dues support activities of local and national organizations.

Story League members come from diverse backgrounds and membership is open to anyone who has an interest in listening to and telling stories.

Meetings are on the third Saturday of every month (except July) between noon and 3 PM at a variety of locations to tell stories, participate in workshops, and share storytelling experiences.
