The **Story Bureau** accepts requests from the general public for storytellers to perform at schools and organizational functions. Requests are forwarded to the Chairperson who presents the requests to the membership (usually at a regular monthly meeting) and asks for volunteers to share the gift of story. If necessary, the chairperson may solicit by telephone. A Request Card File is maintained with the information listed below so the request can be filled.

At the time of the original request, the story bureau requests a minimum donation to the League of \$50 for a performance of 30 to 40 minutes. This donation is to be made by check to the Detroit Story League and mailed to the treasurer (address available upon confirmation). The Detroit Story League, a service organization, is happy to accept donations to help it carry on its work. The storytellers filling Story Bureau requests may submit mileage expenses to the League Treasurer.

The Chairperson of the Story Bureau is ready to fill requests via mail or phone and makes an annual report of requests received and filled.
